2022-2023 COVID Policy

Student Policy:

- Quarantine for 5 days after onset of symptoms, if **POSITIVE**
- Recommended to wear a mask for 5 days after returning to school (if exposed or Positive)
- Parents can choose to quarantine students if there is a Positive Case in the classroom or exposed outside of school
- Vaccinated Students don't need to quarantine if exposed, or have had COVID in the last 90 days
 - Unless symptoms occur after exposure
- If there is a positive case in the household, there is a possibility of quarantine
 - Contact Liz, BC Nurse, for clarification

Employee Policy:

- Quarantine for 5 days after onset of symptoms, if **POSITIVE**
- Recommended to wear a mask for 5 days after returning to school (if exposed or Positive)
- Vaccinated staff don't need to quarantine if exposed, or have had COVID in the last 90 days
 - Unless symptoms occur after exposure
- If there is a positive case in the household, there is a possibility of quarantine
 - Contact Liz, BC Nurse, for clarification
- COVID days have not been approved for this year, so sick/personal days will need to be used

Both:

- We no longer contact trace in school
- School Principals/Front Office will send out a parentsquare notification to individual classes stating there is a positive case in the classroom for parents to monitor for signs and symptoms, and give them the option for their students to quarantine
