#### ASSESSMENT

#### Student Outcomes are monitored in part through assessments.

- iReady Diagnostic is given 3 times a year in Grades K-8 and is a local requirement.
- Dyslexia Screening is completed annually with Grades K-2 and is a state requirement.
- ILEARN or IAM Grades 3-8 is given annually and is a state and federal requirement.
- · PSAT Grades 8-11 is given annually and is a local and state requirement.
- · SAT Grade 11 is given annually and is a local and state requirement.

#### **CURRICULAR MATERIALS**

## Student Outcomes rely in part on access to high quality curricular materials. The BCS K-12 Broad-Based Curriculum Committee and Curricular Materials Work Groups recommend print and digital materials to the Superintendent and Board of School Trustees in Mathematics, Social Studies, Reading, Language Arts, Foreign Language, Science, Visual Arts, Music, Physical Education, Health, and Technology.

#### **SPECIAL PROGRAMS**

## Student Outcomes are achieved when student learning needs are met. Special Education, English Learning, Migrant Education, and High Ability Education are programs for students meeting specific eligibility criteria. Individual learning plans, schoolwide enrichment, compacted curriculum, various accommodations, and differentiated lessons are what it takes for all students to achieve

#### COUNSELING

Student Outcomes are affected by the socialemotional wellness of students and staff. BCS offers a K-12 Model for Comprehensive School Counseling with 2 School Counselors at BCHS, 2 at BCMS, and 1 at each elementary school. #### **EARLY EDUCATION**

Student Outcomes are best for children in grades K-3 when they experience high quality preschool and toddler care. Early Education in BCS is a fully inclusive program. Students with and without disabilities explore, discover and learn together. There are 6 PTQ Level 3 preschool classrooms in our elementary schools and 1 at the Early Education Center. We also have a toddler class at the EEC. Families pay tuition fees weekly. BCCF Scholarships are available to families who qualify. Volunteers are welcome! #### LEARNING RECOVERY

Student Outcomes post Covid-19 were impacted for all students. BCS is using over 1.7 million dollars in pandemic relief funds to implement a K-12 student learning recovery plan over a 5 year period. The plan includes high-impact tutoring, mentoring, embedded professional development for teachers, adaptive instructional software, social-emotional development activities designed to accelerate learning not just fill gaps.

#### **GRANTS MANAGEMENT**

Student Outcomes depend on funding we are awarded through federal, state, and private grants. ### 2022-2023 Student Support Services Highlights



- Launched a systematic process for K-12 Core Subject Curricular Materials Review/Adoption
- 2) Focused on Learning Recovery (Acceleration) through tutoring and mentoring.
- 3) Opened our 7th Early Education Preschool Room and 1st Toddler Room!
- 4) Trained 30 staff K-5 in the *Science of Reading* techniques through the Institute for Multi-Sensory Education (IMSE)
- 5) Implemented a new system for state reporting (student data, course data, and educator data)
- 6) School Counselor ratios met! (250-1)
- 7) 22% Special Education, down from 25%, goal is 15-18%.
