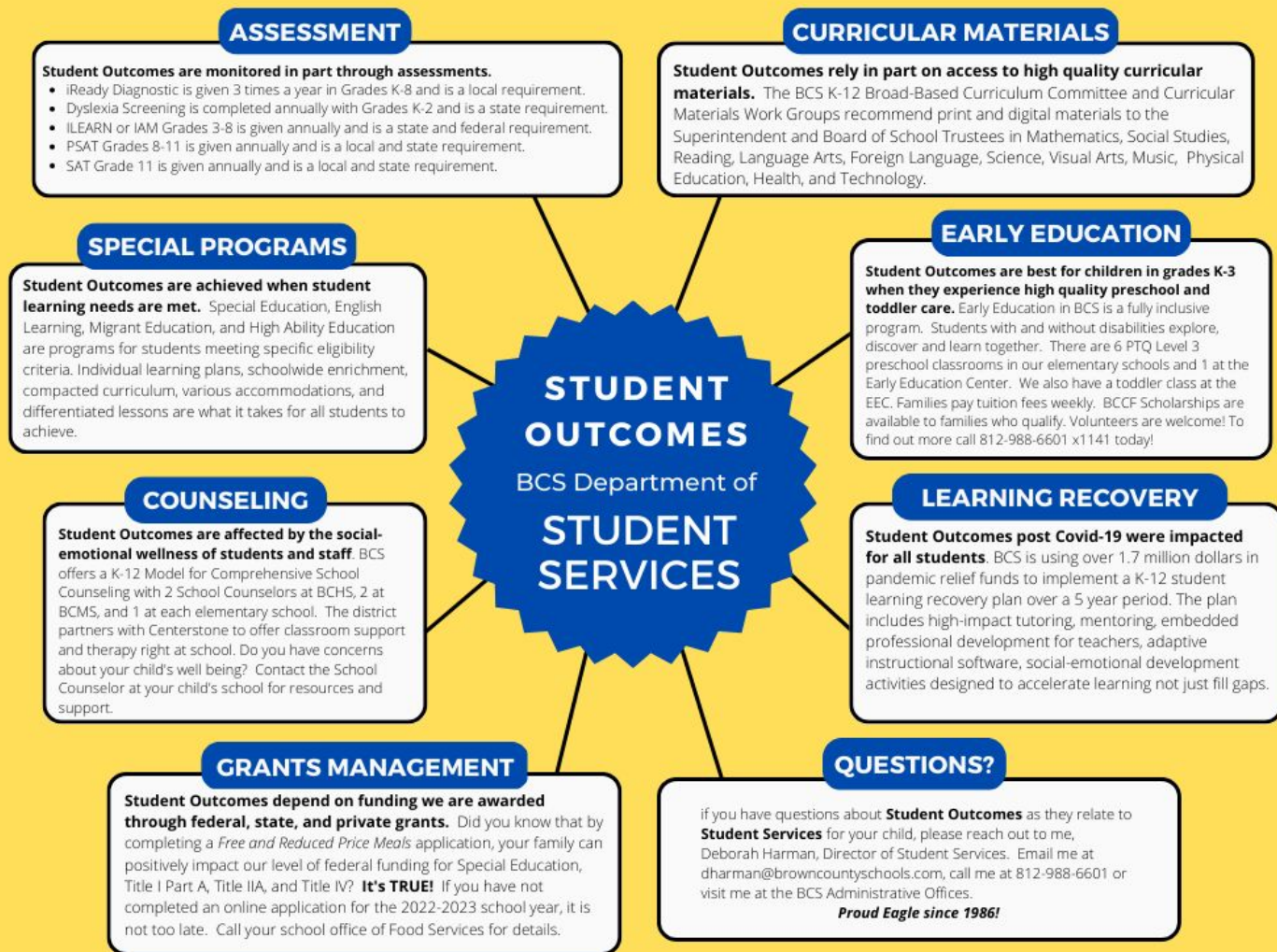


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PK-12 BCS Student Support Services



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2022-2023 Student Support Services Highlights



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- 1) Launched a systematic process for K-12 Core Subject Curricular Materials Review/Adoption
- 2) Focused on Learning Recovery (Acceleration) through tutoring and mentoring.
- 3) Opened our 7th Early Education Preschool Room and 1st Toddler Room!
- 4) Trained 30 staff K-5 in the *Science of Reading* techniques through the Institute for Multi-Sensory Education (IMSE)
- 5) Implemented a new system for state reporting (student data, course data, and educator data)
- 6) School Counselor ratios met! (250-1)
- 7) 22% Special Education, down from 25%, goal is 15-18%.
