## **Course Descriptions**

## PRINCIPLES OF BUSINESS MANAGEMENT

#### 4562 (BUS MGMT)

Principles of Business Management focuses on the roles and responsibilities of managers as well as opportunities and challenges of ethically managing a business in the free-enterprise system. Students will attain an understanding of management, team building, leadership, problem-solving steps and processes that contribute to the achievement of organizational goals. The management of human and financial resources is emphasized.

- Credits: 2 semester course, 1 credit per semester, 2 credits maximum

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#### **Eagle Manufacturing Program Description**

Eagle Manufacturing is a student-run business at Brown County High School. Students in Eagle Manufacturing are considered student-employees and can hold various positions within the business. To be a member of Eagle Manufacturing in Business Management and Administration, students are required to take the Principles of Business Management course outlined above. Once that course has been taken and passed, students will have to complete an application with a resume, participate in an interview, and be "hired" into a position within Eagle Manufacturing. The second course (Management Fundamentals) and the third course (Accounting Fundamentals) in the program of study are both courses in which the student will be holding a position and participating in Eagle Manufacturing.
