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Student Outcomes

- SES will begin the STEM certification process by utilizing the STEM rubric from the IDOE and triggering the certification by the end of the 2022-2023 school year.
- SES students will have 80% students passing IREAD 3 by 2023 through daily reading intervention based in the science of reading.
- SES will be adding Junior Achievement in grades K-5, and 5th grade will attend Biz Town.

School Safety and Security

- SES will have an Advanced trained School Specialist (Principal)
- SES will have another staff member attend the Monthly School Safety Meetings.
- SES will involve students in the checklist of completion in all safety drills. This will be done included in every practice drill this year.
- SES will have an officer in the building monthly during the 2022-2023 school year.

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Recruitment and Retention

- Sprunica will continue to maintain a positive working environment where staff feels respected, supported, and appreciated. All teachers will participate in a mid year check like we did last year. Then an end of the year survey.
- Sprunica will assign our new-to-our-building staff, a mentor, which are required to meet weekly and monthly with Master Teacher. We will conduct and interview with the mentees to see if they felt this program had a positive impact on their first year.



School Family and Community Engagement

- Sprunica students will have the opportunity to participate in afterschool programs that are provided by staff, PTO, IASP, and local partners like Cummins. We will keep records on what percentage of our students participates in this activity.
- SES will continue to display our Eagle Pride through social media, every teacher is required to post something positive once a week. Sprunica will continue to maintain a positive working environment where staff feels respected, supported, and appreciated. (A mid year check in and an end of the year survey.

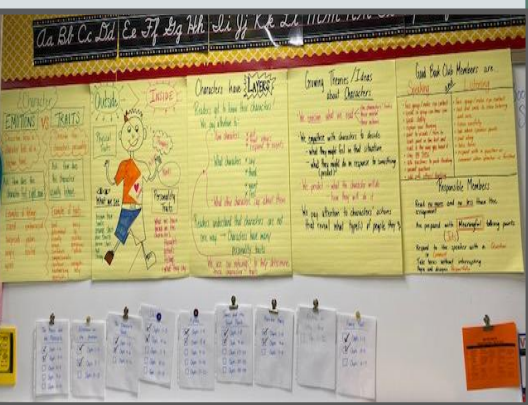

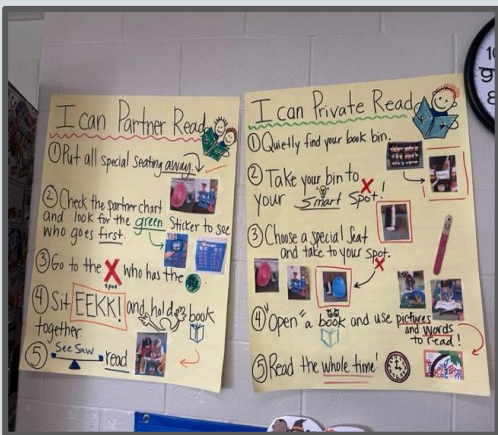


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Reading & Writing Workshop

Goal: Reduce the number of student referrals to the office for students using vapes and dab pens at BCHS.

Strategy: By January 2023, BCHS will install and be able to use 6 vape detectors in restrooms and locker rooms.

Cost: \$15,000

Three staff member will be a certified school safety specialists. (Principal, Asst. Principal, Athletic Director)

Goal: Each new teacher at BCHS will be matched with a veteran teacher of at least 5 years of experience for the first 2 years of employment to assist with lesson planning, classroom management strategies, daily operation procedures, etc.

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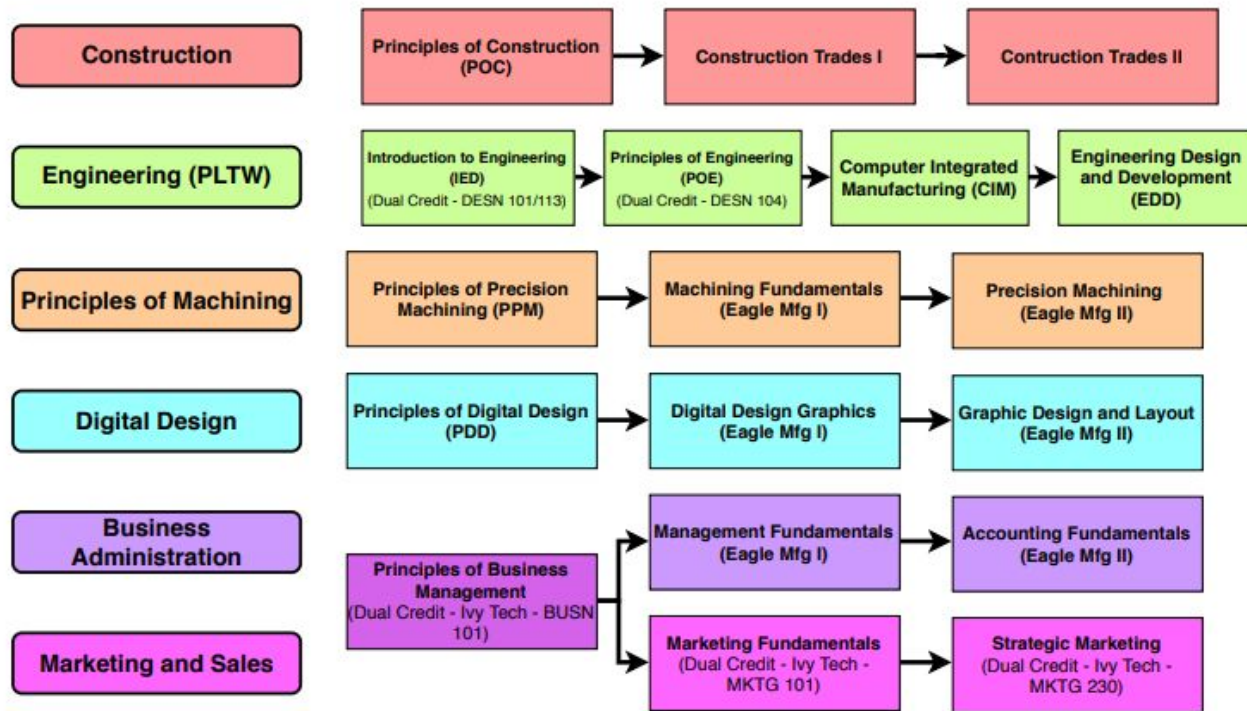

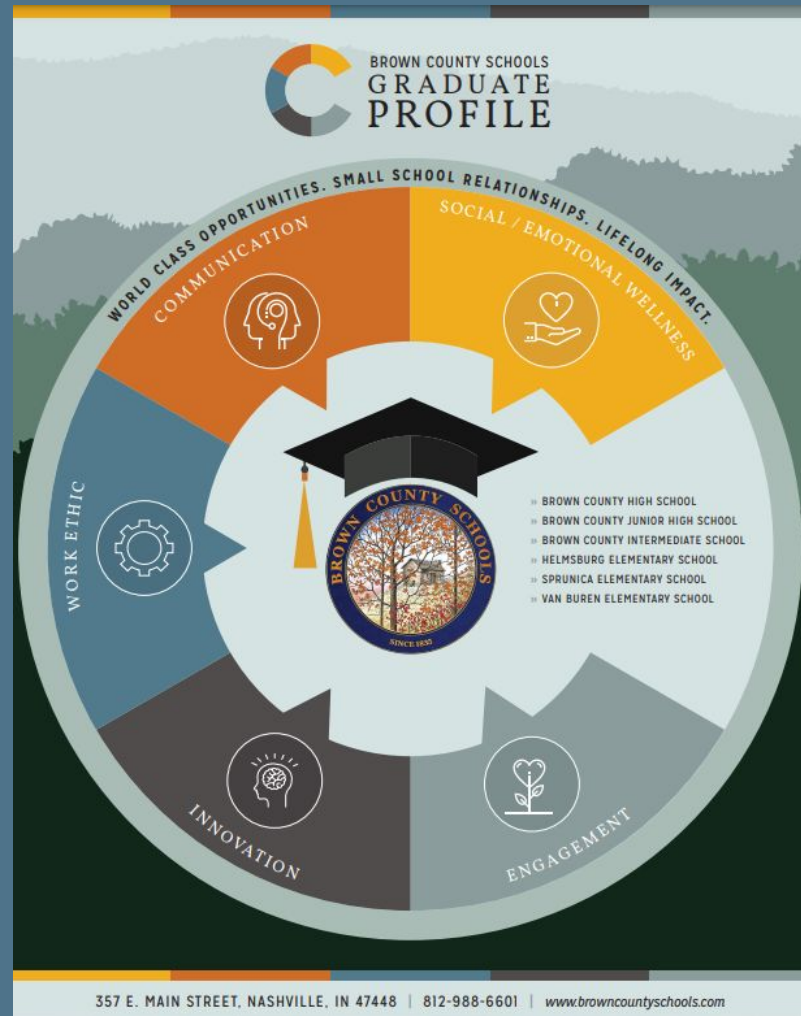
