

GETTING STARTED

- 1) Login (see other side)
- 2) Under Active Assignments you should see one of your courses
- 3) Select All Activities
- 4) We HIGHLY ENCOURAGE you to review the PLATO student orientation and Syllabus for your course
- 5) Select the circle with the plus sign for the unit you want to work on (likely Unit 1 if you are just getting started)
- 6) Take the PRETEST. This will determine what you already know from that unit. If you “test out” of anything, it will be noted with a star
- 7) Work through each topic by first going through the tutorial and then the mastery test

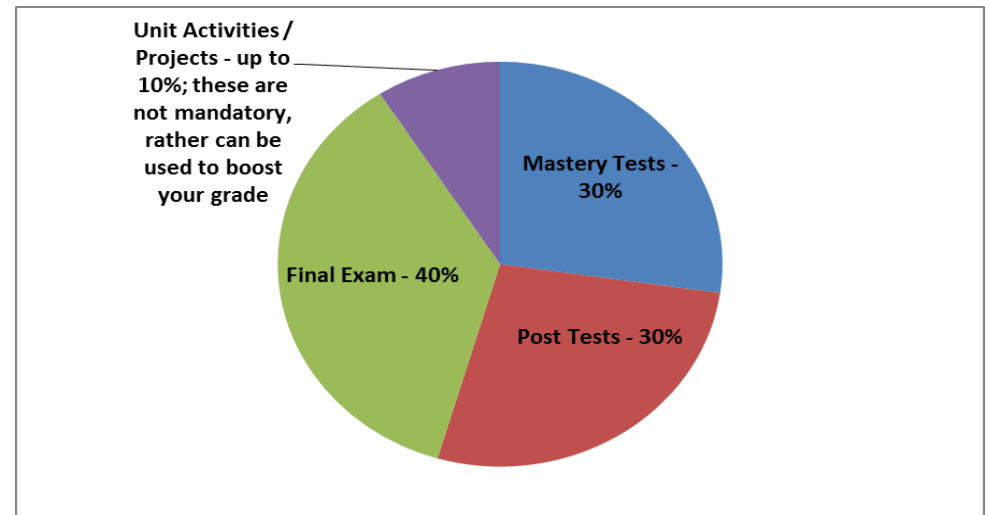
